In an effort to ensure academic assistance for your student, we continue to offer interventions during the school day and after school for identified students through our Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS). Candace Gagliardo will serve as our MTSS Coordinator and you can contact her with questions at gagliardoc@sherrard.us. You may also contact assistant principal Alex Johnson at johnsona@sherrard.us with any questions or concerns.

We are continuing our 70-30 grading policy in our classes, in which 70% of students' grades are based on "summative" assessments (tests, quizzes, projects, presentations, etc.) and 30% of the grade is based on "formative" assessments (homework, classroom assignments, etc). There are some classes that might use an alternative percentage split, but each teacher will provide students with a detailed grading policy on his/her course syllabus.

Sports Physicals for 2023-24

High School Fall sports will begin August 7th, 2023. *All students* participatinging any sport must have a current physical on file before they are allowed to tryout and/or practice. Sports physicals cannot be used for the ninth grade physical. However, ninth grade physicals may be used for sports physicals. Physicals are active for one calendar year plus 30 days from the date of the physical and may only be signed by a physician licensed to practice medicine, a physician's assistant or an advanced practice nurse (NOT a chiropractor). If the physical expires during the middle of a sport season, they will not be allowed to practice or play until a new physical is received. The IHSA sports physical form can be picked up in the office or the high school website. Please contact the athletic office or school nurse if you have any questions.

Dual Credit Students:

Juniors and Seniors:

Please join the Google Classroom for the Counseling Office. A lot of important information will be communicated this way over the course of the school year. Check your email for join codes.

Juniors:

If you are interested in taking the NMSQT exam (practice test for the SAT and National Merit Scholarship qualifying exam), watch for an announcement in your Junior Google Classroom to sign up. The test will be administered at Sherrard High School during the school day. See Mrs. Drish with any questions.

Juniors and Seniors:

If you are interested in taking the ASVAB exam (military entrance and career aptitude exam), watch for an announcement in your Google Classrooms to sign up. Taking this test does not sign you up for the military, or commit you to them in any way. Student scores will not be released to the military unless requested. It does, however, help match interests with abilities and skills. It can also help match possible career choices for the future. The test will be administered at Sherrard High School on November 16th during the school day. See Mrs. Drish with any questions.



Medication Administration

All students who will need to take medications at school, either

prescription or over the counter medications must provide a doctor's order and signed parent permission to the school at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year. Medications will not be administered without a doctor's order.

Medication forms are available on the District web site at www. sherrard.us. Select departments, health services, and health forms. There are forms for daily and as needed medications, inhalers, allergies and diabetes. Students may carry and self-administer inhalers provided the proper paper work is completed. Please select the correct form. Forms are also available at the various schools throughout the district.

NINTH GRADE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS for SCHOOL YEAR 23-24

- All ninth grade students are required to have an updated school physical.
- State law requires Illinois Department of Public Health form to be used
- Physical forms are available at the school and on the school district web site <u>www.sherrard.us</u>, go to *Departments* and select *Health Services*, *Health Forms* and *Student Physical Form*.
- Physicals must be completed and signed by a physician licensed to practice medicine, a physician's assistant, or an advanced practice nurse. Chiropractors MAY NOT perform school or sports physicals.
- Parents or guardians are required by state law to complete and sign the **health history** portion on the back of the physical form.
- Sports physicals will not fulfill this requirement. The ninth-grade physical may be used for a sport physical for 395 days from the date of the exam. Students who receive freshman physicals March 1, 2023 will need another sports physical by April 1 of 2024, if they desire to participate in spring sports. Please keep this in mind when scheduling your child's physical.
- Call for vaccine and physical appointments prior to end of this school vear.
- A copy of your child's immunization record may be required by the health care provider.
- STUDENTS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH PHYSICAL AND IMMUNIZATIONS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL PER STATE REQUIREMENTS. Completed physicals must be turned in by 10/15/23 or students will be excluded until physicals are completed.

All 9th grade students must have a current dental exam dated after 11/15/22 or waiver completed by May 15, 2024. Forms are available on the district web site, select **Departments**, **Health Services**, and **Health Forms**.

2023-2024 IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT FOR TWELFTH GRADE

*This information and a copy of students' immunization records will be included in the registration information which will be sent home with 11th grade students in January.

All students entering the **12th grade** shall show proof of having received two doses of the **meningitis vaccine** prior to entering the **12th grade**. The first dose shall have been received on or after the **11th birthday**, and the second dose shall have been administered on or after the **16th birthday**, and at least eight weeks after the first dose. If the first dose is administered when the child is 16 years of age or older, only one dose is required.

STUDENTS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL ACCORDING TO SCHOOL CODE AND DISTRICT POLICY. Please provide verification of vaccines by the first day of school. Students not in compliance by October 15, 2023 will be excluded until requirements are met.

***NOTE: This must be the Meningococcal vaccine (Menactra or Menveo). The Meningitis B Vaccine otherwise known as Trumenba or Bexsero **does not** meet this requirement. Some pharmacies such as Walgreens have administered the Meningitis B vaccine instead of the Meningococcal Vaccine.

Notices regarding the need for the vaccine are given to the students when they register for classes for the 23-24 school year. Please contact the school nurse if you did not receive this information from your student.
