

### **Student Hunger Drive**

The Sherrard NHS Student Hunger Drive sponsored by River Bend Food Bank has come to an end! The students did an excellent job this year leading initiatives to raise physical and monetary donations for their own and surrounding communities. NHS students were involved in many activities to support the Hunger Drive such as \$5 Fridays, trick or treating for canned goods, and advocating to get the elementary and intermediate schools in our district involved. The students' outstanding efforts are shown through this year's outcome. With the gracious help of our community and staff, Sherrard NHS collected 5,296 pounds of food, which includes all funds calculated into pounds. In monetary donations the students raised around \$1,800, surpassing our goal of \$1,500. With all of this considered, the Hunger Drive has provided 11,515 meals that will be donated in 23 counties in eastern lowa and western Illinois by River Bend Food Bank. We are so proud and grateful for everyone in our community who participated to end the hunger epidemic in our surrounding communities.




### JH Field Trip - Nahant Marsh

# DENTAL REQUIREMENT FOR CURRENT 9<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STUDENTS Dental Exams due May 15, 2024



The State of Illinois requires dental exams for all **9**<sup>th</sup> **grade students**. Students currently in **9**<sup>th</sup> **grade** are required to have a completed dental exam or waiver on file by **May 15, 2024**.

- School dental exams must have been completed after **November 15, 2022**.
- The IDPH dental exam form must be used.
- Exams must be performed by licensed dentists.
- Dental waivers are allowed if:
  - Student is enrolled in free and reduced lunch program and does not have dental insurance.
  - Student is enrolled in free and reduced lunch program and is ineligible for public insurance (Medicaid/All Kids).
  - Student is enrolled in Medicaid/All Kids, but the family is unable to find a dentist or dental clinic in the community who will accept Medicaid/All Kids.
  - Student does not have any type of dental insurance and there is no low-cost dental clinics in the community that will see the child.
- Religious exemption is allowed if religious exemption form is completed.
- Dental appointment cards are accepted as long as the appointment is scheduled within 60 days of May 15. Completed dental exams must be turned in by the beginning of the following school year.
