ACADEMIC INFORMATION:

The Counseling Department has a Google Classroom for the Class of 2022 and 2023 where we will be providing important information relative to each class. Students have been sent a link or Google code to join.

Attention **SENIOR** parents/guardians and students:

There is a FAFSA informational meeting on <u>September 22nd at 6pm in the high school auditorium</u>. This will be a brief presentation on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). A representative from ISAC (Illinois Student Assistance Commission) will be available to help answer questions. The FAFSA is very important for any students considering continuing to a 2-year or 4-year college after graduation. Technical schools, like Midwest Technical Institute, also take the FAFSA. The application opens October 1st every year.

Black Hawk College is hosting a college night on <u>September 30th from</u> <u>5-6:30pm in Building 3</u> (upper gym). Dozens of colleges will be on hand to answer questions about:

- Admission requirements
- How to apply
- Financial aid and scholarships
- Upcoming deadline and more

The <u>NMSQT (National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)</u> is being <u>administered on October 26th</u> during the school day. This is an OPTIONAL college preparatory test as well as the National Merit Scholarship qualifier for JUNIORS only. Students wishing to take the exam can sign up through the Counseling Office Google Classroom, or stop by and see Mrs. Drish.



On <u>November 16th, Sherrard will be administering the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery, or ASVAB</u> exam during the school day. This is an OPTIONAL exam offered to Junior and Seniors. This test is the military entrance exam, but can also provide very valuable career information. Student scores will not be released to the military unless requested. MENINGITIS VACCINE REQUIREMENT FOR 21-22

The State of Illinois requires all students entering the **12th grade** for the 2021-2022 school year to provide proof of having received the **meningitis vaccine** (also known as Menveo, Menactra) **on or after their 16th birthday.**

***NOTE: This must be the Meningococcal vaccine (Menactra or Menveo). The Meningitis B Vaccine otherwise known as Trumenba or Bexsero **does not** meet this requirement. Some pharmacies such as Walgreens have administered the Meningitis B vaccine instead of the Meningococcal Vaccine.

STUDENTS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH IMMUNIZATION REQUIRE-MENTS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL ACCORDING TO SCHOOL CODE AND DISTRICT POLICY. Please provide verification of vaccines by the first day of school. Students not in compliance by October 15, 2021 will be excluded until requirements are met.

Your child's immunization record has been included with the needed vaccine listed.

Students may receive their immunization from their health care provider. Vaccines are also available at Mercer County Health Department in Aledo 582-3762, Rock Island County Health Department in Rock Island 793-1955, School Health Link in Rock Island 732-0958 and Walgreens. You will need to make an appointment and inquire about insurance and cost.

NINTH GRADE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS for SCHOOL YEAR 21-22

- All ninth grade students are required to have an updated school physical.
- State law requires Illinois Department of Public Health form to be used.
- Physical forms are available at the school and on the school district web site www.sherrard.us, go to Departments and select Health Services, Health Forms and Student Physical Form.
- Physicals must be completed and signed by a physician licensed to practice medicine, a physician's assistant, or an advanced practice nurse. Chiropractors MAY NOT perform school or sports physicals.
- Parents or guardians are required by state law to complete and sign the **health history** portion on the back of the physical form.
- Sports physicals will not fulfill this requirement. The ninthgrade physical may be used for a sport physical for 395 days from the date of the exam. Students who receive freshman physicals March 1, 2021 will need another sports physical by April 1 of 2022, if they desire to participate in spring sports.
- A copy of your child's immunization record may be required by the health care provider.
- STUDENTS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH PHYSICAL AND IM MUNIZATIONS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL PER STATE REQUIREMENTS.

• **NEW REQUIREMENT**: All 9th grade students must have a current dental exam dated after 11/15/20 or waiver completed by May 15, 2022. Forms are available on the district web site, select **Departments**, **Health Services**, and **Health Forms**.
